The Clean Heat Standard is a climate plan from the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) which aims to reduce building emissions, but at great cost to Massachusetts residents.

The plan, as written, excludes biofuels, natural gas, oil, propane, and wood & pellets, forcing Massachusetts residents to rely solely on electricity, a more expensive and unreliable option. This plan will put independent retailers out of business and drive up your utility bills.
