- 5/7 & 5/25 participated in the first two of the DPU stakeholder meetings for the MA DPU roadmap process. This process will go through March 2022.
- 5/6 submitted written testimony and email campaign for NH member on SB 86 Energy Choice Omnibus Bill
- 5/5 submitted written testimony on RI Carbon Tax Bill
- 4/19 email campaign for NY members calling for a cost-benefit study by the CAC
- 4/8 submitted written testimony on Rhode Island climate policy legislation (SB 78)
- Submitting written testimony on CT SB 882
- 4/14 we got another win. CT HB 6386 has been significantly modified to place the burden on the gas canister producers
- 3/9 we offered testimony - MA Clean Energy and Climate Plan for 2030
- 3/18 we testified in opposition to H 5967 Climate Adaptation Fund bill to create a carbon tax on petroleum products. Held for further study
- 3/4 testified on RI H5279 in opposition of a bill to restrict energy siting for propane bulk plants and other energies. Held for further study
