State Bill Tracking

NEHPBA is currently tracking over 130 bills for our seven states. Some of these are still concept bills and have not released language yet. We expect hearings to begin shortly on several bills of concern and urge members to answer our Calls to Action when they are sent out. This is going to be a much more active legislative session than last year.
